

**Elementary Science Teacher - Grades 1-5**

St. Peter School is looking for a science teacher for grades 1-5.

Primary responsibilities:

- Provide comprehensive support to students
- Help to maintain a warm, nurturing, and organized learning environment
- Fulfill administrative duties (e.g. attendance, etc.)
- Monitor transitions, lunch, and recess blocks
- Help to manage student behavior

Qualifications - candidates should have or possess:

- Strong communication skills and the ability to build collaborative relationships with families and coworkers
- Enthusiasm for working with and supporting the development of children

Education requirement:

Bachelor's degree (or higher) in science, education, or related field

The 1-5th grade Science position at Saint Peter School follows the Nancy Larson Science Curriculum. This well designed program allows for students to explore and investigate science topics ranging anywhere from cells in biology to birds in ornithology! Students in each grade level are provided with booklets for each unit of the curriculum. There are around six units for every grade and assessments and lesson reviews are provided per each unit. The curriculum can also be accessed online through the Nancy Larson website, which also provides resources for teachers to supplement lesson plans, and resources for students to review anything that was taught or shown in class. This curriculum used to be aligned to the Massachusetts state standards for science, but the standards have been revised as of 2016.

Instruction is provided for the fourth and fifth grades four times per week for 45 minute blocks. Instruction for the first, second, and third grades three times a week for 45 minute blocks.
